OTTAWA COUNTY PROBATE COURT REQUIREMENTS FOR CHANGE OF NAME OF ADULT

An applicant seeking a change of name of adult must provide the following forms, documentation and filing fee to the Ottawa County Probate Court:

- 1. New Case Information Statement
- 2. 21.0 Application for Change of Name of Adult
- 3. Certified Birth Certificate
- 4. 21.01 Affidavit in Support of Application for Change of Name of Adult
- 5. Release for Record Check
- 6. 21.5 Notice of Hearing on Change of Name (The Court will fill in the hearing date, time & address.)
- 7. Deposit of \$185.00

The Court will need to know the city, county, state you were born in, **if not** listed on the birth certificate.

The Application will be scheduled for hearing approximately 6-8 weeks after it is filed.

The Court will do notice by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the county at least thirty days before the hearing.

<u>IMPORTANT INFORMATION</u>: From the Ohio Department of Health - Vital Statistics Website:

When a legal name change has been granted to a person whose birth occurred in Ohio our office will accept a certified copy of the court ordered legal name change to update the birth record. The court order must have been granted by a US court. Some courts may send the certified* copy directly to our office, while some may require the petitioner to do so.

Once the legal name change is accepted by our office, a footnote will appear on the birth record indicating that a legal name change is on file. In addition, the new name as exactly listed on the court order is the name that will be reflected in the updated birth record.
